Nothing Too Hard for God

C & D – His Power Over Every Problem & Every Person

God Cannot Be Overwhelmed

☰ C. NO PROBLEM TOO GREAT

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."
– Psalm 46:1

- > He parted the Red Sea – no obstacle stands before His sovereign will
- > Jesus calmed the raging storm with a single word (Mark 4:39)
- > He raised the dead – no circumstance is beyond His power

God's Grace Reaches the Unlikely

🔗 D. NO PERSON TOO LOST

"Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief."
– 1 Timothy 1:15

- > Saul of Tarsus - persecutor of Christians, transformed into Paul (Acts 9)
- > The thief on the cross - saved in his final moments (Luke 23:43)
- > No soul is too broken, too far gone, or too sinful for His saving grace

A & B. Unwillingness & Unconcern



BARRIER A

Unwillingness

Refusing to Surrender to God's Will

Man chooses to walk away from God's call rather than yield. The rich young ruler turned from eternal life to keep his possessions. Jonah fled in the opposite direction rather than obey.

Unwillingness is not ignorance — it is a deliberate choice that closes the door to God's mighty work.

Matthew 19:22 — *The rich young ruler "went away sorrowful."*

Jonah 1:3 — *"Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the LORD."*



BARRIER B

Unconcern

Spiritual Apathy & Lukewarmness

Spiritual indifference is just as dangerous as open rebellion. When we grow cold toward God's kingdom, prayer, and His Word, we become lukewarm — neither hot nor cold. God warns that this state is deeply offensive to Him and robs us of His transforming power in our lives.

Revelation 3:16 — *"Because thou art lukewarm...I will spue thee out of my mouth."*

Amos 6:1 — *"Woe to them that are at ease in Zion."*

Key Truth: Both Unwillingness and Unconcern are not passive conditions — they are active choices that limit God's power and work in our lives.

C, D & E. Unreasonableness, Uncleanness & Unbelief



C

Unreasonableness

Stubbornness and hardness of heart — refusing to hear God's voice or respond to His gentle call to reason.

Isaiah 1:18

"Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD."



D

Uncleanness

Sin creates a wall between man and God. Iniquity in the heart silences prayer and separates us from His power.

Isaiah 59:2 & Psalm 66:18

"Your iniquities have separated between you and your God."



E

Unbelief

The greatest barrier of all. Jesus could do no mighty works because of unbelief — faith is the key that unlocks God's power.

Mark 6:5-6 & Hebrews 11:6

"Without faith it is impossible to please him."

THE FOUNDATION

God's Word **Stands Forever**

ISAIAH 40:8 — ETERNAL WORD

∞ "The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever."

God's Word is unchanging — the antidote to every limiter man places on God's power.

PSALM 119:105 — GUIDING LAMP

💡 "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."
Scripture illuminates the way through unwillingness, unconcern, and unbelief.

JOHN 1:1 — THE WORD IS GOD

📖 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."
The Bible declares His limitless power — His Word and His nature are one.

"His Word is the **antidote to all five limiters** — it promises, answers, solves, saves, and endures forever.

— ISAIAH 40:8

Will You Believe?

🔒 **Remove the five barriers** — unwillingness, unconcern, unreasonableness, uncleanness, and unbelief — that limit God's power in your life.

★ **"All things are possible"** to him that believeth — faith unlocks the limitless power of the God for whom nothing is too hard.

🙏 **Final call:** Trust the LORD, the God of all flesh — surrender every barrier and believe in His limitless, unchanging power today.
