# Faith Must Be Passed Down

## **Biblical Mandate**

**Deuteronomy 6:6-7** commands us to "repeat them to your children" - faith transmission is not optional.

## **Scripture Examples**

**Psalms 78:4** vows "we will not hide them from their children; we will tell the next generation."

## **Four-Generation Chain**

**2 Timothy 2:2** creates a chain: Paul → Timothy → faithful men → others.

## **Practical Responsibility**

Family worship, teaching moments, and intentional discipleship ensure faith continues.

*Paul to Timothy (1 Timothy 1:2)*



## Bridge Builders

Middle generations connect different age groups, translating wisdom while embracing change and growth.

*Elijah to Elisha (2 Kings 2:9-10)*

Each generation contributes distinct spiritual gifts and perspectives that strengthen the body of Christ together.

# Point 3: We Must Close the Gap, Not Protect It

## Protecting the Gap

-  Age-segregated ministries keep generations separate
-  Separate worship services limit intergenerational connection
-  Missed opportunities for mutual learning and support
-  Weakened faith transmission between generations

-  Multigenerational worship brings all ages together
-  Shared testimonies across age groups inspire faith
-  Mentorship programs connect wisdom with energy
-  Mutual learning strengthens the entire church body

## Key Ministry Areas

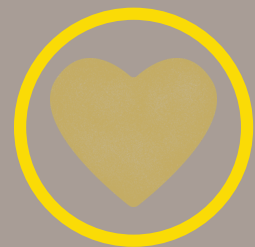
- 01 🏠 Family Worship Practices**  
Scripture recounting during family devotions, teaching children to share testimonies of God's works in their lives.
- 02 🏛️ Church Programming**  
Milestone ceremonies for graduations and baptisms, multigenerational small groups that bridge age gaps.
- 03 🎤 Testimony Sharing**  
Regular opportunities for all ages to share how God has worked in their lives, creating living testimonies.
- 04 🤝 Service Opportunities**  
Shared service projects where young and old work together, demonstrating God's love through action.

## 🗺️ IMPLEMENTATION ROADMAP

- 1 Start Family Programs** **Months 1-3**  
**Focus:** Launch family worship training and milestone celebration planning.  
✓ Equip families with tools
- 2 Expand Church-Wide** **Months 4-12**  
**Focus:** Implement multigenerational groups and regular testimony sharing.  
✓ Bridge age gaps actively
- 3 Sustain Legacy Culture** **Year 2+**  
**Focus:** Embed intergenerational ministry as core church culture and identity.  
✓ Living testimony tradition

*"And they sing **the song of Moses** the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb... for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest."*



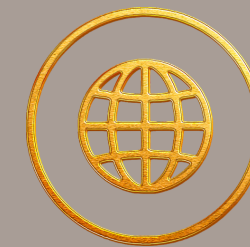
## PERSONAL COMMITMENT
